### PRE-CRUISE DESTINATION REPORT

DATES: 4 May 2006

Title of Cruise: Volvo Parade of Sail

Destination: [39° 3' 30" N 76° 24' 0" W](#), Baltimore Light at mouth of Magothy River

Navigation: Straight forward head out of the Magothy into the Bay, head towards the light.

Anchorage: Definitely in the open, hoping for fair winds and seas will then drop hook and allow for rafting up, looking at going south of the light, again depending on weather and wind direction. If weather doesn't cooperate will heave too, or sail back and forth, hopefully on a beam reach.

Activities: A simple day cruise out the River to watch the Volvo Parade of Sail. Out to Baltimore Light area looking to arrive around 1230-1300 hours. If conditions are conducive will drop the hook and we can raft up to watch the parade pass us from North to South. Start time in Baltimore is 1200 so very rough *guestimate* is 1330-1430 past the light. Every one bring own drinks and munchies for the day. Will monitor VHF Channel 71. As of Sunday night the forecast is for moderate winds, nice temps but also mentions scattered T Storms.
