

### **Queenstown Cruise, June 10-11**

Queenstown Creek is located off the Chester River, about seven miles from Love Point. The town was the first county seat of Queen Anne's County and still has reminders of its Colonial days 350 years ago. Today Queenstown has an excellent golf facility and one of Maryland's largest discount shopping malls.

The first entrance mark for the creek is Red "2" located about 2.5 miles from the green bell marking the entrance for the Kent Narrows. From Red "2" proceed southeast up the narrow channel to Green "5". Charts show the channel to be 7 feet deep, but there are reports of shoaling. Proceed with caution! Plan to anchor in the main branch of Queenstown Creed which heads northeast after Green "5".

No golfers indicated a desire to play, so MRSA did not arrange starting times. If you have had a change of heart you may contact the Queenstown Harbor course directly and make your own starting reservations. You can find them on the web [www.mdgolf.com](http://www.mdgolf.com)

From the town landing it is a short walk to the shopping mall, and I will have a car available if you would rather ride.
