. Directions to the pier at Poes' Shore Shack are:

Route 100 toward Gibson Island
Follow Route 100 East until it merges onto Mountain Road
Take Mountain Road past the Volunteer Fire Department (on your left)
You will pass through the light at Lake Shore Drive.
Continue 3/10 mile past the stop light to the 2nd right at North Shore Road.
Turn right on North Shore Road.
Come to a fork in the road at about 5/10 mile.
Stay straight at the fork (do not curve left) staying on Eagle Hill Road.
Immediately turn right on Shady Lane (it is hard to see the sign)
Follow Shady Lane for about 1.2 miles.
Pass thru two mushroom driveway pillars.
You will see a long chain link fence on your right.
Road turns right along chain link fence. Take first gravel driveway to the left.
House is directly in front of you. Beige with blue shutters.
