We're happy to be able to announce a new destination for our Frostbite Cruise. The Maryland Yacht Club, a full service yacht club, has welcomed us to enjoy their spacious grounds and club house with a great view of Rock Creek and the Patapsco River. We will be selecting from their varied menu with reasonably priced dishes prepared by their gourmet chef. Slips are available for those coming by boat for a fee of \$1.50 per foot. Festivities begin at 6:00 pm.

By car – Take Rt. 2 or Rt. 100 to Magothy Bridge Road. Follow Magothy Bridge/Hog Neck to end. Turn right onto Ft. Smallwood Rd. and travel 2.3 miles to Fairview Beach Rd. (there is a sign to Fairview Marina and Maryland Yacht Club) and turn left. Go to the end. There is a buzzer at the gate to have them open it.

- By boat - Enter Patapsco River.
- At mouth of Patapasco River turn to port after passing Brewerton Channel green buoy "5".
- Proceed on course 244 degrees Magnetic, passing the white rocks on your starboard.
- Proceed into Rock Creek.
Maryland Yacht Club sits on your port side after passing between red day marker "4" and lighted green day marker "3".

If you plan to use a slip, let us know and we will send you a form for the slip.
